



Harrison College Ltd Student Dress Code

We strive to maintain high standards of appearance at Harrison College and encourage parents to support us in ensuring our students arrive for the day looking smart. Not only does this teach students the importance of presenting themselves appropriately, but it also prepares them for the world of work when uniforms or dress codes are necessary - this is particularly important for our students who are accessing work placements.

All Harrison College students and employees are expected to wear smart/professional attire. An indication of what this entails is detailed below:

Female students:

Jacket

Tailored trousers (jeans, tracksuits are not permitted)

Skirt (knee length)

Shirt, blouse, jumper, polo shirt (hoodies are not permitted)

Black shoes – that can be polished. Stilettos, wedges, kitten heels, UGG boots and trainers are not permitted

Coat

Bag – to fit an A4 ring binder

Jewellery – female students are permitted to wear a watch, 1 necklace, and studs in the ear.

Bracelets, rings and any other forms of jewellery are not permitted. Piercings are only permitted in the ear.

Hair – to be natural in colour, no extreme hairstyles are permitted.

Make-up – discreet make up is permitted.

No visible tattoos.

Male students:

Jacket

Tailored trousers (jeans, tracksuits are not permitted)

Shirt, jumper, polo shirt (hoodies are not permitted)

Tie is optional

Black shoes/boots – that can be polished. Trainers are not permitted.

Coat

Bag – to fit an A4 ring binder

Jewellery – male students are permitted to wear a watch and studs in the ears.

Other forms of jewellery are not permitted. Piercings are only permitted in the ear.

No visible tattoos.

Students are expected to wear business dress at all times in College, on external visits when representing the College and also on work placement, unless otherwise stated in their work placement contract.
