JOB OF THE WEEK

Archivist



Archivists and curators collect, appraise and preserve collections of recorded and other material of historical interest.

The annual salary is between £21,000 - £60,000 and you are expected to work 38 – 40 hours.

The workforce is projected to grow by 5.7% over the period to 2027, creating 900 jobs.

LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION

The most timely estimate of pay rolled employees for January 2023 shows another monthly increase, up 102,000 on the revised December 2022 figures, to 30.0 million.
