Beauty Therapist

Beauticians and related workers give facial and body beauty treatments, apply cosmetics and dress wigs.

Beauty Therapists can expect to be paid annually between £16,000 and £21,000 on average. You will also be expected to work evening and weekends.

The workforce is projected to contract by -1.3% over the period to 2027, losing 1,300 jobs.
