DIETITIAN

Dietitians are qualified and regulated health professionals that assess, diagnose and treat dietary and nutritional problems at an individual and wider public-health level.

Dietitians expect to be paid annually between £25,000 and £45,000 on average. You may also be expected to work evening and weekends.

The workforce is projected to grow by 8.7% over the period to 2027, creating 5,000 jobs.

In the same period, 53.7% of the workforce is projected to retire, creating 31,100 job openings.

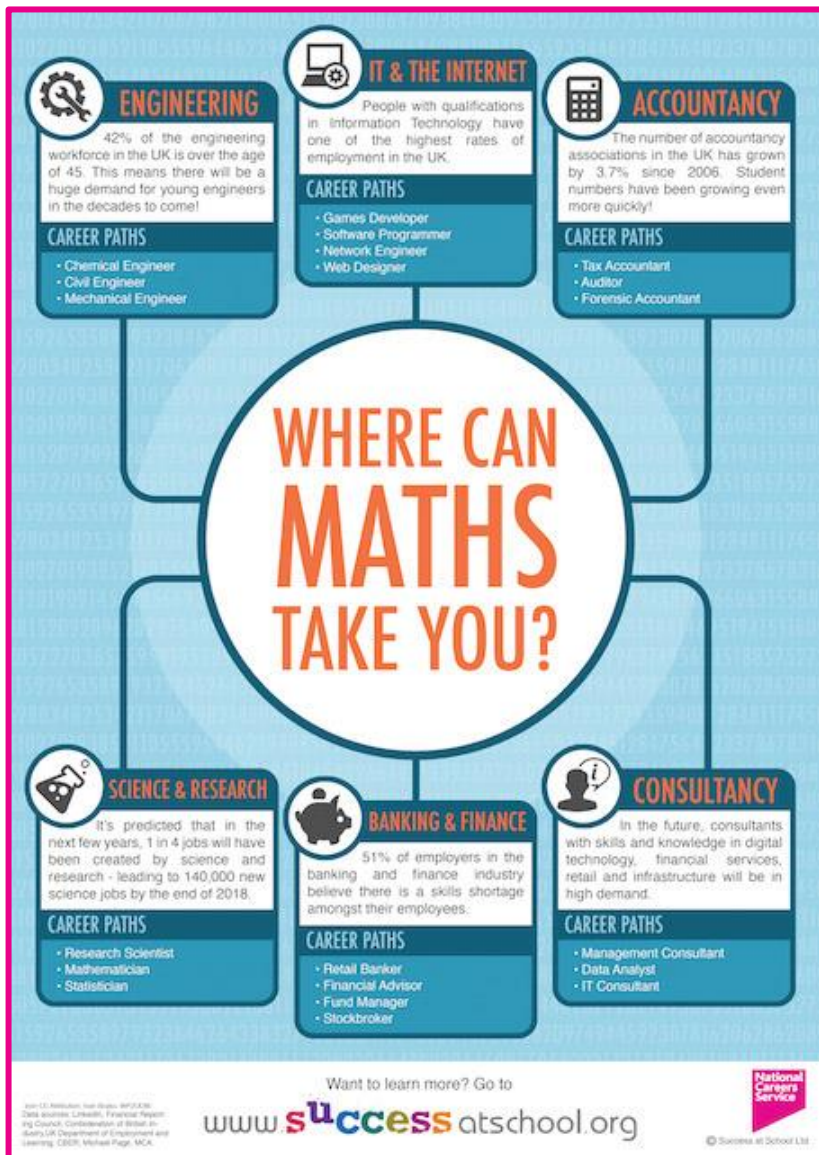


SPOTLIGHT
