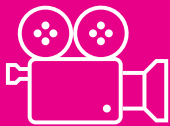
Are you looking for an apprenticeship when you leave Harrison College? [Here](#) is where to start your search.

JOB OF THE WEEK

Electrician

Electricians and electrical fitters assemble parts in the manufacture of electrical and electronic equipment, and install, maintain, and repair electrical plant, machinery, appliances and wiring.

Electricians can expect to be paid annually between £18,000 and £42,000 on average. You may also be expected to be on call and work weekends

The workforce is projected to contract by -8.6% over the period to 2027, losing 20,600 jobs.

In the same period, 50.3% of the workforce is projected to retire, creating 121,200 job openings.
